EAR CUFFS

- Stacking separate pieces onto one ear, and creating the illusion of stacking like with multi row piece on bottom left by Bauble Bar
- Trending motifs such as the star burst and heart drive newness, also chainlink

























LINEAR EARS

- With the rise of night-to-day dressing, drop earrings are being updated with with ultra feminine materials and designs
- Mixing pearls and rhinestones with motifs such as hearts and stars
- Continuing the stacking trend to multiple long strands for an opportunity in multi-packs

















LINEAR EARS: CHAINS

- Taking the drop style to a more casual silhouette with chain
- Varying sizes and thicknesses of the chains, and adding details such as mixed metals and encrusted rhinestones

HOOP NEWNESS

- Fat and multi row hoops seen a lot on runways as well as mass, coming from the 80s power dressing trend
- Updating the oversized skinny hoop with thicker hoops in various finishes, textures, and shapes
- Multi-rows creating the illusion of multiple piercings

HOOP NEWNESS

- We see quilting trend called out in Details section coming through even in jewelry
- Spiral and quilted hoops are both alternatives to clean fat hoop
- Gold dominates, but silver coming through as well





















HOOP NEWNESS: RHINESTONES

- Delicate jewels in various shapes lining the entirety of the outer side of the hoop
- Multi colored jewels add pops of color
- Popular in all sizes from large to huggie


















HOOP NEWNESS: CHARM HOOPS

- Coated in colored enamel or lined with rhinestones
- Layering to spell words or tell stories
- Emerging largely from Instagram 'ear party' trend and brands such as Alison Lou, ManRepeller, Vanessa Mooney



NOVELTY HOOPS

- Coming off Asia shopping trip, we saw a lot of these matte finishes in velvet/chenille and rubberized plastic in various shapes and textures
- Adding motifs into hoops combines her love of hoops and top icons of season



















RING A DING DING!: OPEN CUFF RINGS

- We previously called out open cuff bracelets and the trend has now moved into rings
- Ranging from delicate jewels to large statement pieces, we love the new way to do personalization!
- Often shown stacked with other delicate silhouettes

















RING A DING DING!: COCKTAIL RINGS

- The rise of formal dressing paves the way for antique looks and styling
- Commonly seen with large-scale stones, hand-carved surfaces, or 3D florals
- Merchandise with contrasting rings to encourage multi-stacking styling



RING A DING DING!: SIGNETS

- Cocktail rings with a flat surface, usually seen with stamping or lettering on top
- Looks can be accomplished with metal, enamel, and stones



















RING A DING DING!: STACKABLE RINGS

- Multipacks of rings where the rhinestones are placed around the entire perimeter
- In bold rainbow colors and dainty single-jeweled pieces
- Another growing social media trend, the more stacked, the greater the impact!













MORE HEARTS

- Using a variety of materials besides metals such as jewels, colored plastics, abalone and pearlized shell
- Consider multipacks with all different hearts in a variety of shapes and materials
- Choker Jewelry, Vanessa Mooney, Kendra Scott all had great examples of newness in hearts













MORE HEARTS

- Using them in bold ways paired with a chain and coating them in colors
- Look to new ways of marketing across color runs and mixed metals





















BUTTERFLIES

- Coming from top icons, we see butterfly trending largely in jewelry
- New charm hoop silhouettes look great in multipack shell versions (from Chvker brand)



PASTEL JEWELRY


- Coming off of Power Pastels top trend, we see pastel jewelry emerging for spring

- Hanging charms with letters or motifs
















NEW CHOKERS: CHAINS

RHINESTONE COLLARS


















SPECIAL OCCASION JEWELRY: NECKLACES
